### My class at home: How can I help my child?

### Advice to families of students learning French in Primary Schools



Schools are currently closed in France. It is important to keep a link between your child and his/her teacher.

His or her teacher has given your child notebooks or books. The teacher will suggest activities for your child to continue learning.

To succeed, your child needs your attention. You don't have to do "lessons" but thanks to you, he will be able to understand the exercises, revise and work well.

**In case of any difficulties**, you can contact the teacher or the headmaster.



#### KEEP UP THE PACE

- Don't wake up late
- Offer ritualized activities such as reading, writing and listening activities in French language **every day**
- Plan a schedule with times for learning and times for **breaks**
- Explain the schedule
- Limit time in front of screens

#### WORK ON MEMORY



- Write the different activities of the day (notebook, work plan)
- Set goals for the day
- Check if goals are reached at the end of the day
- Tell what you have learned in your mother tongue or in French
- Learn poems, songs, tell a story or listen to a story, revise your lessons

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#### VARY ACTIVITIES

##### Encourage your child to:

- Read, sing, do maths, write texts, correct them ...
- Listen to stories, describe images, watch videos, tell stories...
- Recording his/her voice: words, texts, poems, songs, stories...
- Play board games, card games, construction games, puzzles, disguises...
- Use learning applications



#### TALK ABOUT DAILY LIFE ACTIVITIES

##### Encourage your child to:

- **Speak about all these activities** in your mother tongue or in French
- Speak about current events, about moments you share
- Cook : read or write recipes
- Draw (a plan of the house, plants, a recipe, stories...)
- Do sports activities: dancing, walking ...
- Do manual activities, gardening, making objects ...
